Rule Changes:
  1. The League shall be known as 'The Sutton and District Badminton League'. It is a non-profit making organisation. All profit and surpluses will be used to maintain or improve the league. No profit or surplus will be distributed other than to another non-profit making body or to members on winding up or dissolution of the league.
  4. An Annual General Meeting will be held before 1<sup>st</sup> October in each year. The Secretary will give clubs at least 7 days notice prior to the date of the meeting. The Secretary shall give 14 days notice of any proposed changes to these rules.
  10. Clubs entering more than one team in an individual competition (Mixed, Ladies, Men's, Hybrid, Fours and Moorman Cup) must advise the Secretary of the nominated names of the senior team(s) before any match is played in that competition by their club. Named senior team players cannot play in any lower teams. You can nominate up to 12 players per team. If nominated names are not received, those that play in the first match for the senior team will become the nominated players. This may cause lower teams to have their players retrospectively checked for eligibility (this can be avoided by playing one senior match before any lower team matches).  
  
3 out of 6 (in Fours matches, 2 out of 4) nominated players must be used in each match. Otherwise, all players used in a team will become nominated as well as all existing nominations.
- A member who plays on more than two occasions during the season for any senior team shall not be eligible to play any further matches for a lower team.
13. (additional).  
It must be borne in mind that if the away team cancels the match there is the possibility of it incurring a payment (half court costs or roughly £30) if the home team are unable to use the courts or cannot cancel the hiring. If costs are not paid and the clubs meet in the same

competition the following season, the home club has the option claim a walkover for their home match.

16a. In the Moorman Cup the committee will decide an appropriate format. Expenses of each match are to be shared. The Final will be played on a neutral court ~~at the end of the season~~.
